The Financial Analyst will serve as a business partner to the **multiple Business Unit's to assist with understanding their financial stories** and help drive predictable outcomes through **robust budget and forecast** efforts.

**Responsibilities:**

- Gather data on a weekly and/or monthly basis and organize it into a digestible format for the business units.
- Able to work on **large data sets, extract and compile data** from different sources and tie it back with our financials.
- Update product and maintenance trending reports.
- Provide information on growth and attrition by product line.
- Based on finding, provide actionable insights to business.
- Consistently update **forecasts**.
